The Doctrine of Salvation: Life in the Son

SEMESTER DESCRIPTION

The doctrine of salvation (or soteriology) is, in many ways, the keystone of the Christian faith. It describes the very basis of our participation in the works of God and charts the course toward our heavenly hope. There are two dangers, however, in the study of soteriology. On the one hand, we may fail to see the beauty of our Redeemer behind the haze of cold and abstract theological jargon. On the other, we may ignore all talk of doctrine and insist we only want Jesus (while ignoring many of the things Jesus himself said!). Neither of these options represents a faithful approach. The aim of this semester in TEC is to grasp the deep theological truths of our salvation while also connecting them to the person of Jesus Christ.
